(Statement of Faith)

1. **We believe** the Bible to be inspired, the only infallible, authoritative, inerrant Word of God (II Timothy 3:15, II Peter 1:21).
2. **We believe** there is one God eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1, Mathew 28:19, John 10:30).
3. **We believe** in the deity of Christ (John 10:33), His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Mathew 1:23, Luke 1:35, His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, Hebrew 7:26), His miracles (John 2:11), His vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrew 2:9), His resurrection (John 11:25, I Corinthians 15:4), His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19), His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelation 19:11).
4. **We believe** in the absolute necessity of the new birth by the Holy Spirit for salvation, and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16-19, John 5:24, Romans 2:23 Romans 5:8-9, Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5).
5. **We believe** in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost, they that are saved unto the resurrection of life, and that they are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29).
6. **We believe** in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9, I Corinthians 12:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28).
7. **We believe** in the present ministry of the Holy spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live in a godly life (Romans 8:13-14, I Corinthians 3:16, I Corinthians 6:19-20, Ephesians 4:30, 5:18).
8. **We believe** in the authority and the autonomy of the local church as God's primary means for evangelism and discipleship in the world, and therefore, we encourage our students to be involved in a local congregation.
