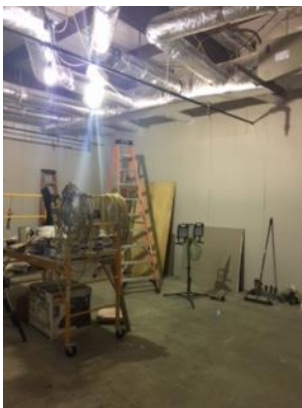
National Spelling Bee- Congratulations! Micah Geise will be representing RCCA in the National Spelling Bee on May 4-5 in Washington D.C.
