Ed Choice Scholarship News-The Ohio Department of Education has received more than 11,000 scholarship requests for the Ed Choice Expansion Scholarships. The scholarship office is running way behind in processing the requests. Of the 70 RCCA has uploaded only 22 have been accepted so far. Renewal scholarships are awarded first. The remainder are awarded based on level of need. If your family does not receive an Ed Ex Scholarship you still may apply for a FAST scholarship. We will work out a payment plan that is very sensitive to your income.
