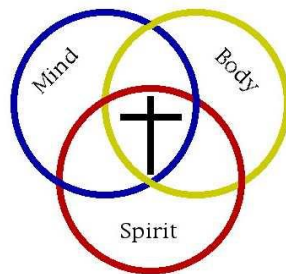
**Parenting Tip-** Growth: a Learning Process
